



## Frequently Asked Questions

### Location

ACC Liverpool, King's Dock, Port of Liverpool, Kings Dock Street, Liverpool, L3 4FP.

### Security

To promote and encourage a safe and secure environment, ACC Liverpool employ a range of event security measures. Security and stewarding staff will be on-site throughout the event. Bag searches will take place on entry so please ensure you arrive in good time.

### Conference registration

All conference attendees, delegates, speakers, exhibitors etc, must register on arrival. Registration will be located on the ground floor through the main doors on the city side entrance.

Approximately one week prior to the event, all attendees will be issued with a unique QR code. Please present this code to the registration staff who will produce your conference badge and lanyard.

It is essential that all delegates wear their badges throughout the conference. Failure to do so may result in non-entry. Replacement badges will be available from the registration desks if necessary. Please note that proof of identity will be requested before replacement badges are issued.

### Cloakroom

ACC Liverpool has a staffed cloakroom for delegates. The venue recommends that you don't bring anything larger than a laptop bag, or A4-size bag, if possible. Please use bag storage at your accommodation wherever possible.

### Wifi

### Conference app

NCASC is a paperless conference with all programme and speaker information on the conference app. Instructions on how to download the app will be issued in the joining instructions. App support will be available on site, located near to the conference registration desks.
